

Client Intake Form

Have client complete and review list of medications.

Medical Clearance

It is highly recommend that you request this. In the event of a complication, you will have done your due diligence.

3 Hear their Story

Allow the time to hear about their journey. Understand the type of cancer they had, and their treatments.

4 Evaluate

Listen closely, to hear if your client/patient is emotionally ready for this procedure. Some people are still too traumatized.

5 Know your Canvas

Understand the various surgeries and where the tissue originated that you will be working on.

6 Discuss Color and Size

Place 2-4 pigment colors on their décolletage and allow the client to select the most familiar.

7 Design and Shape

Have them stand and draw the appropriate areola size (approximately 4cm), using the Staedtler circle template.

8 Time Involved

Average length of time for this procedure is 1.5 to 2.5 hours

9 Aftercare

Explain how to take care of the tattoo following the procedure. Let them know they may require a touch up appointment.

10 Cost of Procedure

Areola tattoos typically range from \$350.00 to \$1500.00 however, many studios choose to offer discounts and participate in events such as Day of Hope.
